Out-of-Uniform Dress Code

- Clothing that reveals undergarments when sitting, walking, or bending is unacceptable; undergarments are not to be displayed at any time
- Clothing that is overly revealing is inappropriate; this may include clothing that is ripped, torn, low-cut, too short, too clingy/tight
- Clothing with offensive language, demeaning words, gang affiliation, drug/alcohol advertisements or any obvious bad taste is not acceptable
- Shirts and tops are to be appropriately sized to the individual
- Shirts that reveal skin at the waist are not appropriate
- Shirts/dresses must not show cleavage, nor be excessively low cut
- Shirts/dresses with spaghetti straps and halter tops are not acceptable, or should be covered appropriately with a shrug, cardigan, etc
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses should be no more than 2 inches above the knee and should remain no more than 2 inches above the knee at all times
- If you choose to wear shorts/leggings under your skirt or dress, the 2 inch rule still applies
- Hats of any kind are not to be worn inside the school building at any time

Students who are in violation of the special events dress code will be required to dress appropriately before returning to class or attending the school event.

The final judge of appropriate dress for school and extracurricular activities are members of the administrative team.
